KUCHING, Rabu — Rakyat Sarawak yang dilantik dan ditawarkan latihan dalam Perkhidmatan Awam Persekutuan akan diberi keutamaan untuk bertugas di negeri ini khususnya luar bandar.

Pengerusi Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Awam (SPA) Malaysia Tan Sri Mahmood Adam berkata demikian pada sesi sidang akhbar selepas merasmikan pusat Temuduga SPA Malaysia di sini pagi tadi.

Menurutnya, keutamaan itu

sebagai menjawab isu lokaliti yang dibangkitkan membabitkan permintaan masyarakat Sarawak yang mahukan rakyat negeri ini dilantik mengisi jawatan di negeri ini berbanding dari luar.

"Bagaimanapun ia terpulung kepada mereka (anak Sarawak) sama ada mahu menerima tawaran bertugas di kawasan lain terutama pedalaman dan terpencil di negeri ini.

"Ini kerana ada yang tidak mahu bertugas di luar kawasan klahiran masing-masing atau ingin bekerja di bandar sahaja," katanya sambil menambah pengisian jawatan itu merangkumi

semua gred dalam perkhidmatan awam iaitu bermula dari gred 1 hingga 41 mengikut kekosongan.

Tan Sri Mahmood juga berkata, SPA juga akan menghantar pasukan penemuduga ke pedalaman dan terpencil bagi memudahkan calon yang layak menghadiri sesi temuduga tanpa bersusah payah pergi ke pusat temuduga.

"Ini akan membantu mengurangkan beban keluarga mereka menghantar anak yang layak menghadiri temuduga di pusat temuduga yang terletak jauh dari kediaman masing-masing.

"Pada masa ini kita mempunyai tiga pusat temuduga utama iaitu di Kuching, Miri dan Sibul. Di beberapa buah daerah lain seperti Bintulu, Lawas dan Limbang sesi temuduga akan diadakan di pejabat kerajaan atau residen," tambah beliau.

Beliau juga berkata dalam mesyuarat dengan wakil masyarakat Sarawak petang semalam satu perbincangan khas mengenai permasalahan yang dihadapi masyarakat negeri ini terutama anak pribumi kurang memohon jawatan perkhidmatan awam persekutuan.

"Pihak SPA telah memberi penerangan khusus tentang permohonan dan pengisian jawatan di bawah Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Awam Persekutuan supaya dapat memberi gambaran jelas tentang perkara itu.

"Kita juga memberi masa tiga bulan untuk wakil persatuan atau penduduk untuk menerangkan kepada pemohon yang layak mengenai pengisian jawatan dalam SPA persekutuan.

"Selain itu mesyuarat akan diadakan setiap bulan bagi mengenal pasti dan mengkaji permasalahan yang dihadapi anak-anak pribumi serta mencari jalan bagi menyelesaikannya," tambah beliau.

Menurutnya, iklan jawatan kosong dalam perkhidmatan persekutuan turut akan dimuatkan dalam akhbar-akhbar tempatan dan akhbar berbahasa ibunda masing-masing bagi menarik lebih ramai calon memohon jawatan.

SPA lantik anak tempatan isi jawatan kerajaan di Sarawak

KUCHING - Berkuat kuasa serta-merta, jawatan kosong dalam perkhidmatan awam persekutuan bagi kumpulan sokongan gred satu hingga gred 40 di Sarawak akan diisi oleh anak tempatan.

Pengerusi Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Awam (SPA) Tan Sri Mahmood Adam berkata, keputusan itu dibuat selepas mesyuarat SPA bersama wakil jabatan persekutuan di Sarawak dan wakil-wakil badan bukan kerajaan seperti Persatuan Graduan Dayak Sa-

rawak, Persatuan Kayan Sarawak, Kesatuan Kebangsaan Dayak Sarawak diadakan di sini kelmarin.

"Hasil mesyuarat tersebut, kita telah berjanji jawatan kosong persekutuan melalui lantikan oleh SPA di Sarawak akan diisi orang Sarawak sendiri.

"Keputusan yang dibuat bukan satu masalah besar untuk dilaksanakan kerana jika kita lantik orang Semenanjung untuk mengisi jawatan sokongan contohnya seperti kerani, masalah lo-

gistik dan penempatan mungkin pula akan timbul. Jadi lebih baik lantikan dibuat berdasarkan lokaliti," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian pada sidang akhbar selepas Majlis Perasmian Pusat Temuduga SPA Malaysia cawangan Kuching di sini semalam.

Mengulas lanjut mengenai mesyuarat itu, Mahmood berkata, antara masalah yang dibangkitkan ialah tempat temu duga yang jauh, dan terdapat jawatan kosong namun peluang tidak diberi kepada anak tempatan.

"SPA telah melantik 15 orang wakil kaum Dayak bagi membantu SPA memberi penerangan dan membetulkan semula persepsi salah terhadap SPA selama ini.

"Mereka juga telah berjanji akan membantu memperbetulkan tanggapan terhadap SPA, dan dalam tempoh dua hingga tiga bulan ini akan berusaha menarik lebih banyak permohonan daripada kaum Dayak untuk menyertai sektor perkhidmatan awam," katanya. - Bernama

Sarawak utama anak tempatan

Kuching: Kekosongan jawatan dalam perkhidmatan awam di pelbagai agensi Persekutuan Sarawak akan diisi oleh anak tem-

patan, berkuat kuasa sertamerta.

Pengerusi Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Awam (SPA), Tan Sri Mahmood Adam, berkata tawaran dibuka bagi mengisi jawatan berkenaan bermula daripada perjawatan kakitangan sokongan sehingga ke jawatan Gred 41.

Katanya, keputusan diambil selepas SPA mengadakan pertemuan dengan beberapa wakil badan bukan kerajaan (NGO) Sarawak

termasuk Kesatuan Kebangsaan Dayak Sarawak (SDNU), Persatuan Graduan Dayak Sarawak (SDGA) dan Persatuan Kayan.

Nafi dianaktiri

"Rungutan masyarakat Dayak mengatakan SPA menganaktirikan mereka dalam soal pengambilan pekerja tidak timbul kerana pernah berlaku kakitangan awam tempatan enggan berpindah ke kawasan lain di Sarawak.

"Jadi, pihak SPA terpaksa menghantar kakitangan awam dari negeri lain ke Sarawak bagi mengisi kekosongan ini," katanya selepas merasmikan Pusat Temu Duga SPA, di Bangunan Stallion, di sini, semalam.

Mahmood berkata, pengambilan berdasarkan lokaliti penting bagi memastikan tiada masalah membabitkan proses penempatan kakitangan di pedalaman.

Utama penduduk tempatan

"Jika ada kekosongan di Bario sekalipun, SPA akan memberi keutamaan kepada penduduk Bario dulu. Begitu juga di Sarikei, Sibulim, Limbang atau Kapit," katanya.

Sementara itu, Mahmood berkata, daripada 12,913 calon yang mengikuti temu duga, seramai 3,000 calon Sarawak diserap ke perkhidmatan awam dalam tempoh sembilan bulan pertama tahun ini.

西马公务员东渡抢滩引民愤 公共服务委员会通宵开会寻对策

(本报吉隆31日讯) 马来西亚公共服务委员会释出处理砂州人不滿公职录用边缘化的诚意，将优先考虑安排当地人填补公职空缺，而不是舍近求远的由西马调派人手。

公共服务委员会主席丹斯里马末阿当作出“砂拉越的问题，用砂拉越方式解决”的承诺，会以砂拉越人本身的处理与背景，对新录用的公务员，安排在最接近其所在地的公职履行服务，以尽量解决砂人感觉被边缘化的投诉。

就地取材聘公仆

他表示，该委员会是正严正看待和处理砂州人对申请和被录取当公仆感觉被边缘化的问题，会级谈和优先考虑给偏远内陆地区的公职申请者在当地任职。

这是他今日为该公共服务委员会座落在此间大石路两哩半的古晋面试中心主持开幕仪式后，在所召开的一项记者招待会上，如是强调的。

他说，砂拉越所面对的公共服务领域问题与西马有所不同。例如一些偏远地区的巴里奥或巴卡拉兰有公职空缺，公共服务委员会是会优先考虑给当地人申请，以及加以录用和安排就职。

与此同时，他说，该委员会还会安排人手飞往偏远内陆区为合格申请者进行面试活动，省缺内陆地区居民舟车劳顿之苦。

砂州方式解决砂州问题

公共服务委员会已设立一个专门探讨及处理砂拉越人申请和录用公职问题的特别委员会，并于昨晚在此间一著名酒店召开首次会议。

丹斯里马末阿当表示，该会议将开到通宵达旦(至今天凌晨)，已收集各项关系到砂州人要当公务员与公职之难题，并且也达成“用砂州方式解决砂州问题”的共识。

今年首九月66万人申请公职 马末阿当：12万人接受面试

(本报吉隆31日讯) 马来西亚公共服务委员会主席丹斯里马末阿当指出，以新录用的公务员情况推想，足以填补国内公职空缺。

他说，该委员会于2011年，接获112万3692份来自互联网对当公仆的申请。

而今年截至9月30日为止，共有65万9042名公职申请者。该委员会已在去年完成15万159名申请者的面试，而今年首9个月为止，接受面试者则有12万5560人。

他披露，在去年，成功被该委员会录取，分配到不同服务领域任职者有3万6810人；而今年截至9月30日为止，成功被录取者有2万5402人。

他今天为大马公共服务委员会古晋面试中心主持开幕礼致词时，也透露今年截至9月30日为止，砂州共有1万2913人接受该委员会的面试，并有2997人成

功被录取或接受培训。

该委员会去年在砂州，完成共1万4137人公职申请者的面试，并有3310人成功被录取。

另一方面，马末阿当说，随着政府积极推行各项转型计划的努力当儿，该委员会扮演重要的角色，尤其是录取真正有能力及高素质的人才，以分配他们到合适的公职岗位，进而达到政府转型的目标。

他强调，该委员会也会确保在录取人才方面是秉持公平透明的程序，不计申请者的种族、宗教、国籍及各自的政治背景。

据悉，公共服务委员会古晋面试中心全新的装修费用耗资18万9000令吉，于2009年启用，拥有8间面试房间，各1间行政办事处及休息室。

达雅公务员不成正比

他披露，其中一项问题是，砂州达雅族群较多，但是申请当公务员进入公共服务领域者却甚少，与其占幅砂州最多人口不成比例。

因此，公共服务委员会将继续深入探讨这现象，确保各族人民被照顾。

他表示，华裔子弟申请当公务员的

人数仍然不甚踊跃，也是受到类似的问题困扰，而该委员会也透过刊登报章广告以吸引更多华裔申请应征公职。

华裔申请者不踊跃

到目前为止，公共服务委员会在砂州有3个面试中心，包括古晋、诗巫及美里，并且计划在林梦、民都鲁、老越等偏远地区设立面试中心。

PSC interview centres 'everywhere'

KUCHING: The Public Service Commission (PSC) will be going to every corner of Sarawak to conduct interview of candidates applying for jobs in public civil service.

Its Chairman Tan Sri Mahmood Adam said the decision had been made after a meeting with non-governmental organisations (NGOs) from the Dayak community on Tuesday night.

"Last night, we arrived at a decision that Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Awam (Public Service Commission) will go to all corners of Sarawak to conduct interviews.

"Even if we have to interview

only one candidate, we will go. We want the Public Service Commission to be community-oriented.

"If there are candidates to be interviewed in Sri Aman, we will go to Sri Aman, if there are people to be interviewed in Sarikei, we will go to Sarikei, or in Kapit, or in Bau, or in Barlo, or in Ba'kelalan, or in Lawas, God willing, we will go," said Mahmood, adding that this would be in line with the 'People First, Performance Now' aspiration.

Mahmood was speaking at the official opening of the Public Service Commission's interview centre at Stallion Building, Jalan Rock here, yesterday.

PSC now has interview centres in Kuching, Sibu, Miri

Mahmood disclosed that the PSC now had interview centres in Kuching, Miri and Sibu.

"We will continue to set up more interview centres. We will identify suitable building in Bintulu for our interview centre. We are also using the Resident's Office in Limbang, and are looking for suitable government building in Lawas. We will have interview centre everywhere," he said.

He said 659,042 applications for positions in public services were received throughout the country during the first nine months of this year compared to 1.1 million applications in 2011.

"The trend is increasing and we believe that the figure will go beyond 1.1 million this year," he said.

The figure will also increase for Sarawak.

Up to September this year, Mahmood said 12,917

Sarawakians had been interviewed, with 2,967 of them being successful.

He said the PSC had in the pipeline 20 to 30 transformations to be made, and 26 were now being carried out while 20 were being discussed on Tuesday night.

"We still have 20 to 30 more transformations to be made," he added.

Speaking at a press conference later, Mahmood said the PSC had also promised the NGOs that vacant positions in the public service in Sarawak would be filled by Sarawakians.

"Locality factors will be given consideration," he said.

He disclosed that five members from the Dayak community had been appointed to the special committee to study the problems faced by the Dayak community in Sarawak in joining the public service, and they would meet every month.

Sarawak posts for S'wakians, assures PSC chief

KUCHING: The Public Service Commission (PSC) has given its assurance that available federal government posts in the state will be filled by Sarawakians.

Its chairman Tan Sri Mahmood Adam said that an agreement to the effect was reached at after discussions with several Dayak-based non-governmental organisations (NGOs) here on Tuesday.

"We have made a decision that federal government posts

in Sarawak applied through the commission will be filled in by Sarawakians themselves.

"We will do our best to cater to the needs of every state, and in the case of Sarawak, the 'locality' issue seems to be the main concern," he told a press conference at Bangunan

Stallion at Rock Commercial Centre in Batu Lintang here yesterday.

He added that this, in fact, had already started, and was applicable to officers in Grade 41 and below.

Erratic weather expected throughout this month

KUALA LUMPUR: The Meteorological Department forecasts erratic rainfall nationwide throughout November following changing and uncertain wind directions.

According to a spokesperson from the department's Weather Forecast Division, rain and

thunderstorms in the evening are expected to last until early November in the west coast of Peninsular Malaysia, especially in Perak and the Klang Valley.

"In the east coast of the Peninsular and Sabah and Sarawak, rainfall is expected to

increase in November...at this time the northeast monsoon season is in its early stages," he said when contacted by Bernama yesterday.

The spokesperson, however, said the weather conditions will not affect the flow of Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia

examinations from Nov 5 to Dec 6.

"It's still too early for us to make an accurate forecast on whether rain will continue until December," he said, adding another weather update will be issued before Deepavali celebrations. — Bernama

The locality issue Mahmood talked about refers to employing a local person to work in his/her home state instead of employing a person from Perak for instance to work in Sarawak or vice-versa. Problems like logistics and lodging would usually crop up in such instance.

"Therefore, it is best that we appoint Sarawakians to work in Sarawak," he said.

Mahmood said that the (Stallion) centre is one of three PSC Interview Centres in the state. The others were in Miri and Sibu.

He added: "The commission has also made a decision that it will go to all areas such as Sri Aman, Ba Kelalan or Lawas to interview even one person in its effort to look for a suitable Sarawakian candidate.

Commission to go all out to interview prospective employees

KUCHING: The Public Services Commission (PSC) will go to every nook and corner of the state to conduct interviews even if it means there is only one person to be interviewed.

PSC chairman Tan Sri Mahmood Adam said towards that end, the commission would not hesitate to send its officers to the state's most interior part, such as Bario.

Mahmood said this was decided during the commission's dialogue session with the ad hoc special committee on Tuesday night, which dragged on until the wee hours.

The committee which comprises, among others, representatives from the non-governmental organisations (NGOs) and pensioners, has been tasked with looking into recruitment-related grouses and ways to fine-tune the civil service in the state.

"This (decision) is because we do not want to make it difficult for the candidates, especially those from

the interior areas to come all the way to the town centre to be interviewed.

"This is also to give opportunity to our officers to go down to the field and know where are those places," he said when opening the PSC Interview Centre in Jalan Rock here yesterday.

He said the PSC had no problem using venues like schools, canteens or government offices to conduct the interviews as long as the process could be done.

According to Mahmood, currently PSC has only three interview centres in the state - in Kuching, Sibul and Miri.

He said three more would soon be set up in Bintulu, Limbang and Lawas.

"This is part of our transformation programmes to prioritise the people. Currently, we are implementing 26 programmes while another 20 are still being discussed and another 30 new programmes to implemented

using the Blue Ocean Strategy," he added.

On another matter, Mahmood said the PSC had also decided that all the positions for the support group in the federal civil service in the state would be reserved for locals.

"This is due to locality and logistic considerations.

"We will give priority to the locals to serve in the state," he said.

On the grouses that there were very few Dayaks serving in the civil service, Mahmood said the fact was that the PSC only received about 70,000 applications from Sarawakians although the state had about one million population.

"So, in the dialogue session last night, the Dayak representatives had listened to our explanation. We have no problem engaging them as long as we have the vacancies.

"What we need to do is not to make this an issue but to explain and encourage them to join the civil service," he said.

“如果所有人都不同意到乡区服务,那么,该委员会还能安排谁去?”

他说,该委员会在分配公务员的工作岗位和服务地区时,都会考量到申请者的来历,并依据他们的背景安排适合他们的职位、岗位等。

在该方面,该委员会采取了雇用当地职员填补当地岗位空缺的措施,希望能改善公仆不愿到乡区服务的难题。

他举例,若巴里奥或北干拉三地区的公共服务领域中有空缺,我们会欢迎当地人民申请,优先考量雇用他们。

区工作,若否砂州子民遭边缘化?

他指出,从该委员会的调查数据可见,实际上,乡区人民对公共服务领域不太感兴趣。

他说,尽管砂州达雅族的人数很多,但是申请进入公共领域服务者却很少,因此,该委员会才采取其它途径,包括设立更多的面试中心,以提供有关公共领域的资讯与机会,同时也安排面试奔波各地,上门面试有困难的申请者。

他说,为了减轻内陆地区申请者的负担,面试官将会飞往有关地区进行面试,以填补公共服务领域的空缺,包括新里阿曼或沙拉越的内陆地区。

另一方面,他还声明,该委员会赞同且支持,砂拉越联邦政府机构的岗位与空缺应当由砂州民填补。

他说,经过昨晚至委员与各机构主管和非政府组织代表进行对话后,该委会已对砂州人民所反映出的问题达成共识,今后将以砂州方式解决砂州问题,根治公仆不愿应聘的问题和吸引人民投入公共服务领域。
